Eligibility

This scholarship is open to undergraduate and graduate students who are currently registered as a full-time student majoring in Civil or Environmental Engineering at the University of Central Florida, Polytechnic University of Puerto Rico (Orlando Campus), and Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

Submittal Date

Complete application package must be submitted by **March 29th, 2019**.

Requirements

The following items must be submitted with the Scholarship Application Form for eligibility:

- Short essay discussing interest and importance of water resources engineering (**up to 300 words**)
- Unofficial school transcripts
- One (1) letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the school you are currently attending.
- Full Curriculum Vitae (CV)

Note: Students selected for the scholarship must be present at the Water Resources Seminar in Orlando on **May 3, 2019** to be recognized and receive award (free registration provided).

While not required, membership and involvement with the ASCE student chapter is strongly encouraged and will be considered during the scholarship selection process. Active involvement with other engineering student groups and community involvement / service activities is also encouraged. Attach list of engineering society membership / involvement and community involvement / service activities on separate page.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

- Interest in water resources and / or environmental engineering as evidenced by essay, course work, and CV.
- GPA
- Letter of recommendation from a faculty member.
- Involvement with ASCE Student Chapter, other engineering student groups, and other community involvement / service activities

Application Process

Applicants should submit a complete application package via email to ewrischolarship2019@gmail.com. Other submission methods or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Amount of Scholarship/Announcement of Award
