# 2020-2021 ASCE SEI East Central Branch Structural Scholarship Application

The Structural Engineering Institute (SEI) of the ASCE East Central Branch (ECB) is proud to announce the ASCE ECB SEI Scholarship. This scholarship is part of the SEI commitment to support Central Florida's brightest minds for future careers in structural engineering.

## *Eligibility*

This scholarship is open to full time junior, senior, and grad students with interest in structural engineering field. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Currently registered full-time student majoring in Civil/Structural Engineering at a University within the ECB region.
- Is an active member of his/her local ASCE student chapter.
- Is currently in a good academic standing (G.P.A 3.0 or higher).

## *Application Requirements*

The following documents must be submitted along with the Scholarship Application Form no later than August 17, 2020 for eligibility:

- Short essay (400 words or less) about your interest and the importance of structural engineering.
- Unofficial school transcripts
- Three (3) references with names and phone numbers or e-mails (examples: faculty, employers, co-workers, ASCE Student Chapter Officer).
- Must be available to attend the ASCE Annual Officer Installation luncheon (Sept 18, 2020) to receive the scholarship.

## *Evaluation criteria*

Applicants will be scored based on the following:

- Essay
- GPA
- References
- Involvement with ASCE Chapter/community
- Feedback from reference

## *Application process*

Applicants shall submit a complete application package to [asce.ecb.sei@gmail.com](mailto:asce.ecb.sei@gmail.com) in PDF format no later than **August 17, 2020**. Other submission methods, incomplete applications, or late applications will not be accepted.

## *Amount of Scholarship*

The ASCE ECB SEI will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to an eligible junior, senior, or graduate student currently pursuing a career in civil/structural engineering field. The award will be

presented to the winning student at the Annual Officer Installation Luncheon in the month of September (September 18, 2020). Please make arrangements to attend this luncheon if you are selected.
