### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Is an active member of his/her local ASCE Student Chapter
- Is currently in good academic standing (2.8 overall GPA or higher)

### **REQUIREMENTS**

This following items will need to be submitted with this Scholarship packet no later than **November 1, 2020** for eligibility:

- Career goals essay demonstrating interest in Civil Engineering (**no more than 250 words**)
- Unofficial school Transcripts
- Resume
- Three references with name, title, phone number, and email address (EX: Faculty member, Employer, Coworker, ASCE Student Chapter Officer)

### **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

Applications will be scored using the following criteria:

- Essay (originality, grammar, spelling, punctuation)
- GPA and coursework
- Resume (Presentation & Content)
- Involvement with ASCE Student Chapter (to be verified by ASCE Student Chapter Officer)
- Feedback from references (as necessary)

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

### **AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP**
